## ICN Engagement Officer

### Key Responsibilities

- **Moderate forum discussions** – Facilitate conversations, encourage participation, and ensure discussions remain active and relevant to N-of-1 trials and single-case designs.
- **Collaborate across ICN roles** – Work closely with the Communications Officer and Website Officer to promote member engagement opportunities. Take direction from the ICN Chairs to align outreach efforts with broader network goals.

- Familiarity with N-of-1 trials and single-case designs
- Strong communication and networking skills
- Comfortable facilitating online discussions
- Experience using LinkedIn or similar platforms for professional engagement

### Volunteer Commitment and Length of Service

This role requires approximately 1-2 hours per week to engage members and moderate discussions. The standard term for this position is 1 year, with the opportunity for renewal based on interest and availability.
